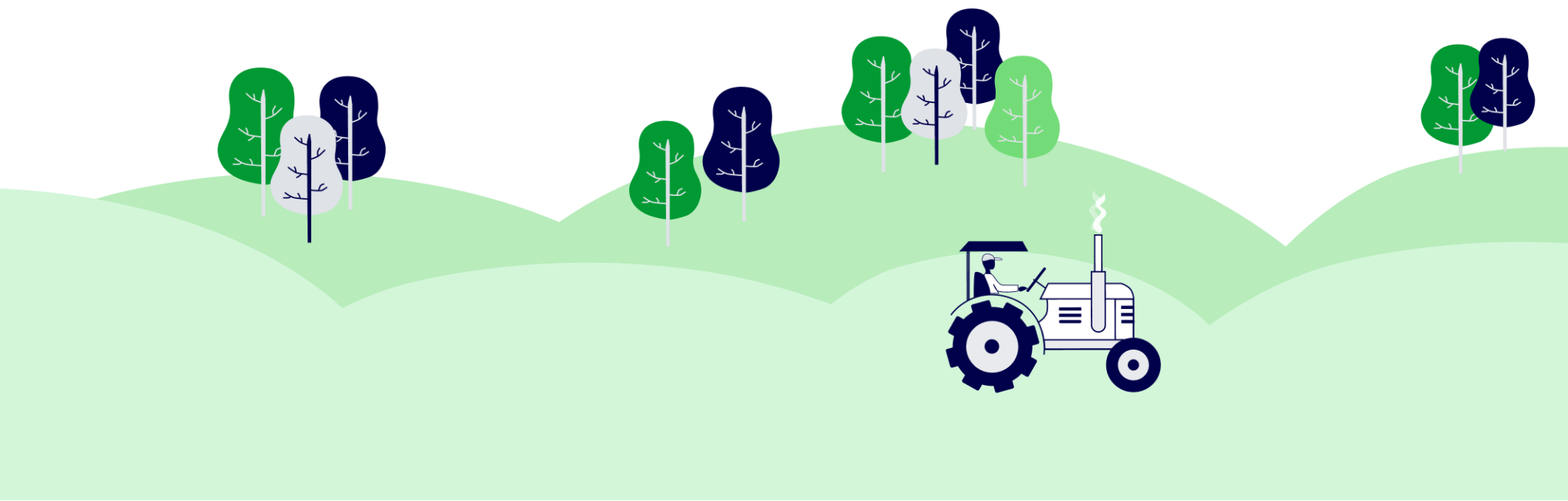

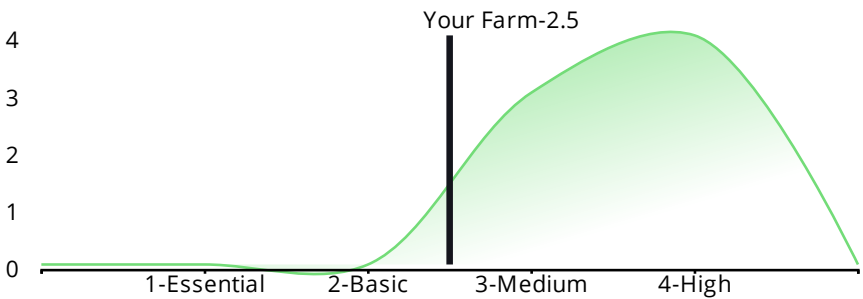
Biodiversity and Habitat

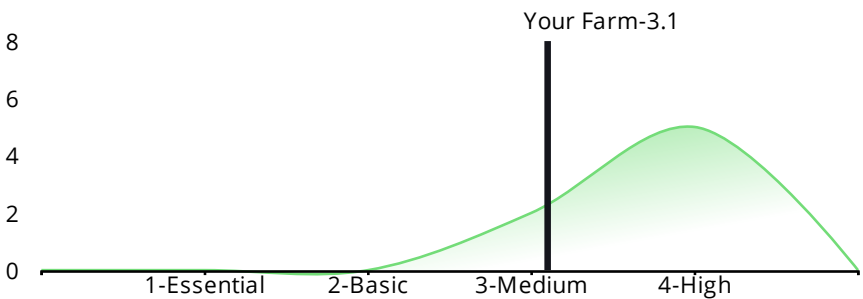
Soil Health

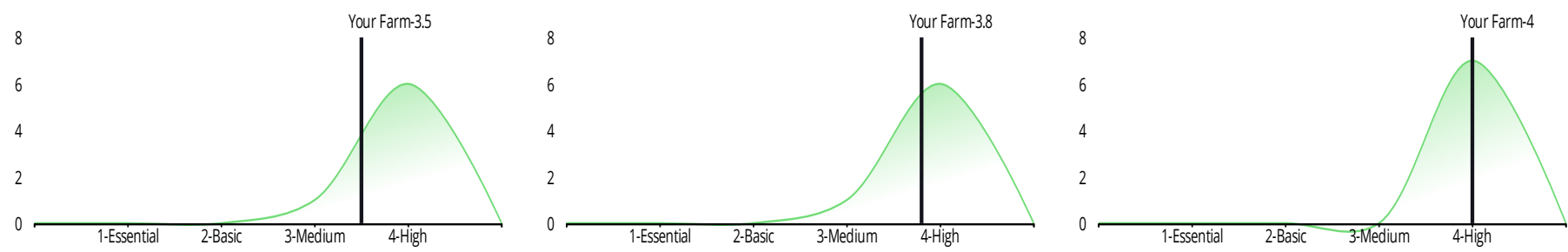

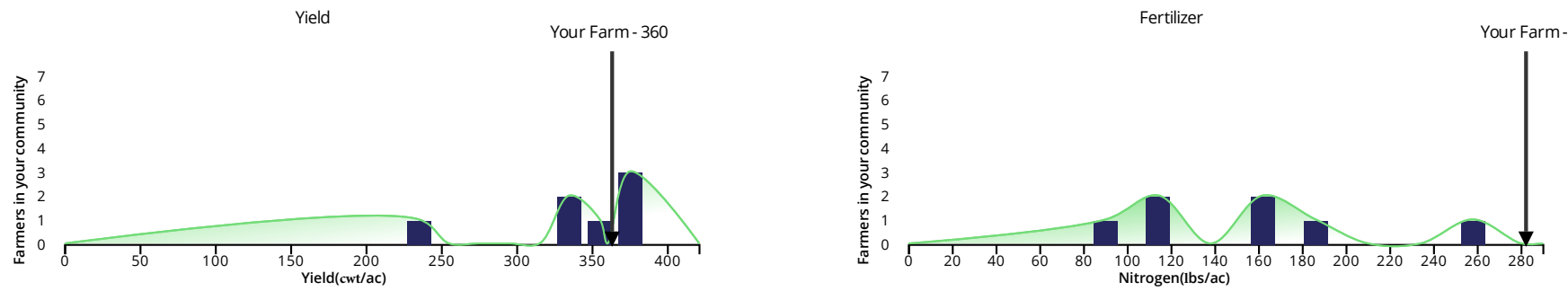


Management Practices
